CASTING A VOTE: To vote for the candidate of your choice, darken the oval (●) to the LEFT of the candidate's name. If you make a mistake, return your ballot to the Election Official and obtain another. Do not attempt to erase any marks made in error.

WRITE-IN: To vote for a write-in candidate, write the name of the candidate on the line provided and darken the oval. A write-in vote will NOT be counted unless the vote is for a DECLARED write-in candidate.

STRAIGHT PARTY VOTING: You may vote a Straight Party Ticket for all the candidates of the party of your choice by darkening the oval for the party in the STRAIGHT PARTY section. Your voting mark will give every candidate of that party a vote. Then move to the NONPARTISAN OFFICES, JUDICIAL RETENTION QUESTIONS and PUBLIC QUESTIONS and vote as desired.

SPLIT-TICKET VOTING: You may vote a Straight Party Ticket by marking ONE of the party choices and then voting for individual candidates of your choice in any other party OR you may vote for individual candidates of your choice in each office.

JUDICIAL RETENTIONS AND PUBLIC QUESTIONS: To vote on Judicial Retentions and Public Questions, darken the oval to the LEFT of the word "YES" or "NO."
