Charged: Dealing in a Schedule II controlled substance within 1,000 feet of a public park, a Class A felony. Bay, who at the time was an employee of the Johnson County Sheriff's Office, reportedly sold three Vicodin pills for \$15 total to a police informant in March. Officers taped the deal.

Charges: Dealing in marijuana of more than 30 grams, a Class D felony. Hardcastle reportedly sold a half-pound of marijuana valued at \$600 to an undercover police officer last month.

Charges: Dealing in a Schedule II controlled substance within 1,000 feet of a public park, a Class A felony, and dealing in marijuana of more than 30 grams, a Class D felony. In February, Cooper reportedly sold a quarter-pound of marijuana to an undercover police officer for \$325.

Charge: Dealing in a Schedule II controlled substance within 1,000 feet of a public park, a Class A felony. A police informant agreed to meet Gonterman at his home in March, where Gonterman reportedly sold the informant \$60 worth of methadone pills. Police taped the conversation.

In April, a police informant bought \$150 worth of crack cocaine from Conner. On a separate occasion in April, Conner reportedly sold \$20 worth of clonazepam pills to the informant. Police taped both transactions.

Charge: Dealing in a Schedule I controlled substance, a Class B felony.
