### FIND OUT YOUR PROPERTY TAX RATE

The following is a list of Johnson County's taxing districts and the total property tax rates. Rates are per \$100 of assessed valuation. Use the chart to find out your rate. Example: If you live in Franklin Township and in the city of Franklin, your 2008 rate is \$3.62 per \$100 of assessed valuation.

### WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW Bills mailed: On or before Oct. 20

When they're due: For most taxpayers, including homeowners who pay their taxes through an escrow account, farmland and business owners, the total amount of taxes is due Nov. 12.

Making installments: Homeowners who do not pay their taxes through an escrow account have the option to pay in three installments. Fifty percent of the total taxes would be due Nov. 12; 25 percent would be due Dec. 12; and the rest would be due **Jan. 12**. Homeowners have to fill out a form and agreement at the treasurer's office to be eligible for the payment plan.

## **HOW TO PAY**

Local banks will accept payments, including Chase, First National, Heartland, Huntington, Irwin Union, Lincoln, MainSource and M&I. Taxpayers also can mail their payments. They also have the option to pay the bill online at www.johnsontax.net.
