(to be back). It shows they have fortitude and mental toughness."

They also have higher expectations of themselves this year. VanDeman (215 pounds, 25-6) vowed to return and improve on last year's sixth-place finish. But injuries slowed his progress.

Halfway through the season, he injured his right ankle and sat out for two weeks to recover. When VanDeman returned, he pulled his left hamstring because he was favoring his right leg. The nagging injury lasted for three weeks and slowed him until just before the tournament.

Now, for the first time in months, he's healthy. And he's gained confidence as he's advanced. "This is the best I've ever felt going into the state tournament," VanDeman said. "I really got in a groove since sectionals, and I'm gaining steam. I've just wrestled against a lot of good competition, especially late in the tournament."
