Local filmmaker, actor premieres martial arts film at Franklin theater

ctor Chris Cones never for-

gets his Franklin roots. So Agets his Framework when he premiered his new film "Bound by Blood," he made it a homecoming.

The independent film, shot in Indianapolis, played on the big screen for the first time at Canary Creek Cinemas in Franklin on Friday.

Cones described the movie that he produced with co-star Sean Eichenberg of Indianapolis as a Hong Kong-style kickboxing flick.

Cones plays a rebellious kickboxer who finds his own path of justice. He avenges the deaths of his unborn daughter and wife after a drug bust attempt by Eisenberg's character goes awry. The bust also leads to the shooting of their mentor, Master Young Choi.

The two-hour movie, put

together by more than 60 cast and crew members, took 19 days to film. Scenes were set in Indianapolis hotspots such as the Vogue Nightclub in Broad Ripple and 8 Seconds Saloon on the city's west side.

Professional movies of comparable length could take up to six months to shoot.

"Independent films are special because they don't have the Hollywood corporation feel," said the movie's screenwriter, Randy Bettelon of Indianapolis. "It has its own unique style and a very well-told story with local resources."

Another movie by Impact Productions, owned by Cones and Eichenberg, comes out in March with scenes shot in Franklin.

"Rage" is a movie centered on the horrors of child abuse. Cones' 11-year-old son Joshua stars in the movie and plays a murderer.
