

# Creating Noah's Ark in middle of Katrina

**"Little Zoo that Could"** (9 p.m., Animal Planet) celebrates a modern-day Noah's Ark.

In September 2004, with Hurricane Ivan bearing down on their location, the director of Alabama's Gulf Coast Zoo made the remarkable and unprecedented decision to evacuate the animals.

With only 36 hours to spare, and no room at any inns for a motley menagerie ranging from big Siberian tigers to tiny bush babies, the animals were relocated to the zookeeper's house 20 miles inland.

"The Little Zoo that Could," a struggle to save 270 exotic animals, will air in 13 one-hour installments, beginning tonight.

• MTV offers a real alternative for the Olympic-phobic: Two solid hours in "Fat Camp" (9 p.m., MTV). This documentary special follows five campers as they embark for a weight-loss camp in Pennsylvania's Pocono Mountains.

These kids are upfront about their weight and their unhappiness with their self-image. You can't be more upfront than allowing cameras into a dressing room as you try on size XL pants that no longer fit, or underwear that accentuates a protruding belly.

Like many teen documentaries, "Fat Camp" boils down to teen romance, teen insecurities and the vicious machination of teen cliques and pecking orders. Despite the rustic setting, these kids spend most of their time on cell phones, calling friends and would-be lovers just a few bunks away.

With so much talk about food and teen angst, it's hard to tell what's worse for these kids: what goes into their mouths or what comes out of their mouths. • Are you a stickler for details? Do you find yourself second-guessing Martha Stewart on a regular basis? Then "Windsor Castle: A Royal Year" (8 p.m., WFYI, WTU) is for you.

This unabashed puff piece for the British Royal family offers viewers unprecedented access to the Windsor's regal pile, a 1,000-year old castle maintained by a staff with hundreds of years of collective experience. The first installment, "The Banquet," offers a behind-the-scenes look at the preparation for a state dinner honoring the centennial of L'Entente Cordiale, the 1905 peace treaty between Britain and France.

Watch as royal chefs argue over the appropriate menu, and footmen of all stripes fuss over details. There's even a guy who sets the table using a ruler to ensure that the dinner and desert plates are just so far apart. An element of chaos arrives when the cast of the musical "Les

"Miserables" arrives to entertain assembled guests, but a stiff upper lip is maintained by all.

### NEW YORK Britney Spears to join Mardi Gras celebration

Britney Spears, a Louisiana native, will celebrate Mardi Gras in New Orleans later this month when the devastated city hopes to revive some of its old partying ways.

"I am honored to be a part of the Mardi Gras celebration in New Orleans this year," Spears said in a statement Monday. "It is so important for this amazing city to continue its annual traditions and I am really looking forward to being involved."

The 24-year-old pop star will appear on ABC's "Good Morning America" at 7 a.m. Feb. 28, when the morning show reports live from New Orleans. ABC announced that Spears will bring "surprises for a group of very deserving young residents."

The Mardi Gras parade season will run from Saturday to Feb. 28; Fat Tuesday, or Mardi Gras Day, is Feb. 28.

Spears grew up in Kentwood and has participated in fund-raisers for victims of Hurricane Katrina.

The singer also will guest star April 13 on NBC's "Will & Grace." Last week, photos were published of Spears driving with her 4-month-old son, Sean Preston, sitting on her lap instead of being strapped to a car seat in the back seat. She first blamed pursuits by the paparazzi, but later said it was a "mistake." On Monday, Transportation Secretary Norman Mineta chided Spears as irresponsible for driving with her baby son on her lap.

Natalie Portman says she fulfilled a long-standing ambition by shaving her head for the sci-fi thriller "V for Vendetta."

"I was really excited to get to shave my head; it's something I'd wanted to do for a while and now I had a good excuse," Portman told reporters at the Berlin International Film Festival. "It was nice to shed that level of vanity for a girl."

However, "I wasn't used to being looked at so much," the 24-year-old actress said. "Walking down the street, I can usually blend in, and people really stare at you when you're a girl with a shaved head."

The film, directed by James McTeigue, screened outside the competition Monday. Written by Andy and Larry Wachowski, "V for Vendetta" is set in a future Britain run by a fascist dictatorship.

Portman's character, Evey, is saved from an attack by a masked anarchist.

### BURBANK, Calif.

This season's "Gilmore Girls" story line where the normally tight mother-and-daughter team of Lorelai and Rory feuded and gave each other the silent treatment caused some sharp arguments among the show's rabid fans.

Turns out there were some divisions on the set, too.

"It wasn't my favorite," admitted Lauren Graham, who plays mom Lorelai. Lorelai and Rory have since made up; tears flowed. The show's creators are clearly trying to push things and avoid the fatigue that usually afflicts television shows in their sixth season.

Long the WB's most critically acclaimed series, "Gilmore Girls" has grown to become its second most popular after "7th Heaven." Last month's announcement that the WB and UPN will shut down to form a new network in the fall has left all of their programs in flux. But "Gilmore Girls" would seem to have earned the right to determine its own destiny and make the move to the new CW network.

The growth has come despite the widely objected-to story line.

Part of Graham's problems with the feud were personal; she missed working with co-star

Alexis Bledel every day. Primarily she believed it didn't ring true to her character.

"I struggled with the idea that this character, being the parent, would go so far as to stop speaking to her daughter and not make more of an effort," said Graham.

Co-creators Amy Sherman-Palladino and Dan Palladino said it was important to do something that shakes Rory to her foundation, a typical rite of passage for budding adults, who learn about themselves by how they respond.

The future of "Gilmore Girls" is a convoluted plot itself. The Palladinos say they're undecided about whether they will continue with the series after this season.

One factor that may have driven them away — a pilot for a

new series, a romantic comedy, that would have been filmed in New York — is no longer in the picture. It was scrapped with the WB's dissolution.

Television economics may also play a part in the decision. The WB is canceling "7th Heaven" because, after a decade on the air, the network's most popular show was losing money because it was so expensive to make.

"They've come to us before and asked point-blank how long we think the show can go," Sherman-Palladino said, "and we say it's a family show, it can go on forever. If '7th Heaven' could have gone on for 10 years, why couldn't this show go for 10 years? There's no reason. They're going to be hard-pressed to assemble a cast this good on television again."
