MOLES

Trapping moles is considered the most effective means of eliminating moles. Traps should be placed in main activity tunnels, not in the shallow, temporary branches. Moles feed mainly on earthworms but also eat grubs and other small critters. They don't eat the roots and bulbs they displace during tunneling, but the roots and bulbs often dry out and die as a result. Mice and voles use the mole tunnels and feed on roots and bulbs, leaving moles to take the blame.
