Police: Overdose suspected in death

Police are investigating the death of a Center Grove area man.

Scott E. Gilmer, 41, was found dead Friday by a 29-year-old woman who also lived at the residence, 164 N. Bluff Road.

The woman told White River Township firefighters who responded to the scene that Gilmer had injected heroin the night before, a report from the Johnson County sheriff's office said.

The woman told firefighters she woke about noon to find Gilmer not breathing in his bedroom, the report said.

An autopsy done Saturday was inconclusive, and police are awaiting toxicology reports.
