the walls into panels with molding that was inset with iridescent damask wallpaper.

Now that the space was lighter and brighter, it was time for an injection of color.

I selected a palette of rich reds, elegant greens and boudoirlike taupes and mixed and matched these tones in a variety of sensual velvets, tone-on-tone chenilles and buttery soft silks.

The real focal point of the room was the beautifully carved wooden bed, so I dressed it up in regal style.

I put in a soaring, full floor-toceiling canopy with a valance and chenille drapes lined with gorgeous silk gingham.

I then topped it all off with a quilted red chenille damask cover, several throw pillows and even a special cushion that carries

Simon and Kristine's family crest. To further brighten the space, I installed recessed fixtures around the perimeter of the room, installed some lovely sconces to read by, and affixed a delicate lantern-

For some further architectural interest I installed a new vintage-inspired fireplace. I pulled a gas main into the house, cut a hole in roof for the flue and installed an English-manor style fireplace that boasts faux coal instead of logs.

The furniture in the old room was left over from the couple's university days.

I replaced it all with more contemporary pieces that included elegant wooden side tables, a functional armoire, a textured area rug, and a comfy leather

that is perfect for fireside reading and relaxing.

This deluxe master suite was now complete and ready to please both of its masters. The room contains lots of wood, crown moldings and architectural elements for Simon, but also features light walls, delicate wallpaper and

warm touches for Kristine. By using traditional fabrics and finishes, luxurious furniture and handcrafted style, this master bedroom said cheerio to dark and stuffy, and hello to jovial English country manor.


