# Musicians turn their 'Fantasy' into reality

ome go to summer camp for the fresh air. But where do air gui-

tarists go? Why, to "Rock and Roll Fantasy Camp" (9 p.m., TLC), of

While well intentioned, "Try My Life" is nothing you haven't seen three or four times already. Besides, whenever I'm faced with a wretchedly self-absorbed teen, my impulse is to change the channel as quickly as possible.

• "Project Jay" (11 p.m., Bravo) allows "Project Runway" fans to catch up with Jay McCarroll, last season's winner.

'Jay" follows the talented McCarroll as he moves out of his parent's house in rural Pennsylvania and attempts to launch his own clothing line in New York City.

Jay did not accept the "Runway" prize money and hopes instead to make more coin selling and licensing his own work.

Along the way, he runs into some old "Runway" rivals, including Austin Scarlett and Wendy Pepper.

And if finding a New York City retail space and apartment isn't difficult enough, Jay has to drop everything when Heidi Klum asks him to design a dress for the September 2005 Emmy Awards, occurring scant days after the birth of her child.

With all of this on his plate, Jay suffers a serious health emergency that requires immediate and expensive attention. "Project Jay" never reveals who is paying for this freelancer's medical insurance.

McCarroll maintains his quick wit and singular vision throughout, reminding us why he became a favorite on "Runway" and emerged as one of the more original TV personalities of 2005.

Stanfield, a computer-security expert forced to help carry out a \$100 million cyber bank job after a crook takes his family hostage.


#### Singers perform to raise hurricane-relief money
