

# Spring has sprung for baseball fans

**H**ola, it's spring! I don't care what the groundhog saw or didn't see in Pennsylvania last month. I've got my own spring detector, and it's got nothing to do with robins on the wing.

For yours truly, spring officially begins the first time I turn on a television or radio and hear the sound of a baseball game.

I don't listen for the crack of the bat or the "thwap" of the ball against leather. And often I can do without the play-by-play and color commentary. I enjoy the ambient sounds of a lazy, distracted baseball crowd. It's quite different than the hungry roar of a football stadium.

A baseball crowd emits a languorous and indifferent murmur, redolent of boredom, distraction and anticipation. Sometimes you can actually hear individual voices, hotdog vendors and conversations.

In contrast, a football crowd bleats like a near-unanimous mass, screaming, "We want action, and we want it now! (Because we're freezing!)" Baseball fans exude the quiet confidence of people who know they've got all spring and summer to see this through.

Baseball begins in earnest with coverage of spring-training games as well as the games of the World Baseball Classic. America's pastime takes on a truly international dimension tonight when Korea meets Taipei (9:30 p.m., ESPN Deportes).

ESPN Deportes is ESPN's Spanish-language station. Yes, sports fans, that's a game between Korean- and Chinese-speaking players, broadcast in Spanish! Now that's a world series.

ESPN networks will cover the entire Baseball Classic, pitting national teams from Asia, Latin America and the United States. ESPN and ESPN2 will cover 16 games between Tuesday and March 20. ESPN Deportes will carry all 39 games of the classic.

In addition to The World Baseball Classic, ESPN will cover Major League spring-training games beginning Friday, with a game (1 p.m., ESPN) between the Los Angeles Dodgers and the Atlanta Braves from Orlando, Fla.

Noah Wyle returns to "ER" (8 p.m., NBC, TV-14), but he's far from his old Chicago hospital. Dr. Carter and medical colleagues (Eamonn Walker, "OZ," and Mary McCormack, "The West Wing") treat hundreds of refugees in Sudan's war-ravaged Darfur region.

### Missing sex scene was projection error, really

Jason Reitman says a projection error, not Tom Cruise, was responsible when Katie Holmes' sex scene was missing in a screening of her upcoming movie, "Thank You for Smoking," at the Sundance Film Festival.

"I was sitting there in the theater, the scene was missing, and my immediate thought was, 'Oh

my God, Fox cut the scene out of my movie,'" Reitman said in an interview. "And then I realized, 'No, if it's at the end of the reel, the projector probably just accidentally cut it out.'"

Some blamed Cruise, Holmes' fiancé, speculating that he had pressured Reitman to remove the scene.

"That's a fun story. I'd read that story. The problem is that it's not true," the director said. "The problem with 'projection error' is that it's the truth but it sounds like a lie. It sounds an awful lot like 'wardrobe malfunction.'"

Holmes, 27, and Cruise, 43, have been engaged since June. They announced her pregnancy in October.

## 'Office' slowly, steadily growing into hit CALENDAR

Network executives often hear this plea from producers of low-rated, critically lauded TV shows: "Remember how long it took 'Seinfeld' to catch on?"

Usually the suits ignore their cries, swiftly swinging the cancellation ax on low-rated disappointments like CBS's "Love Monkey." Or, in the case of Fox's "Arrested Development," critics shamed the network into keeping it on the air even though its ratings continually eroded.

NBC's "The Office" has been the exception to the rule, following in the ratings footsteps of "Seinfeld." "The Office" began in the Nielsen basement, but slowly and steadily is growing into a hit.

"The Office" had an advantage "Seinfeld" didn't: iTunes. Since it debuted as an online download Dec. 6, at least one episode from "The Office" (and often more than one) has been among the Top 10 iTunes weekly video downloads.

That boost from iTunes coupled with slow-but-steady growth on

Tuesday night, especially among advertiser-desired young viewers, convinced NBC that the time was right to move "The Office" and its higher-rated lead-in, "My Name is Earl," to Thursday nights in January. So far, it's working.

"Earl" and "The Office" don't beat the CBS juggernaut "CSI: Crime Scene Investigation," but they've improved NBC's fortunes. Last season, "The Office" averaged 5.3 million viewers per week; this season it's up to an average of 8.1 million viewers weekly. The network has already renewed both "The Office" and "Earl" for the 2006-07 TV season.

Based on the British series of the same name that starred Ricky Gervais as a terrible boss trailed by a documentary crew, the American "Office" opened its doors with the same format a year ago. Edgy and emphasizing uncomfortable comedy, the American "Office" introduced Steve Carell ("The Daily Show") as Michael Scott, the idiot boss of the Scranton, Pa., branch of Dunder Mifflin Paper Co.

Gervais picked Greg Daniels ("King of the Hill") to exec-produce the American version ("He's a very quiet man, which really excited us for some reason") and said he took the show's poor test results as a positive sign.

"That's exactly what it did on

BBC2," Gervais said last week. "The people that get onto focus groups are force-fed big, broad comedies with laughter tracks and guest appearances. They're not going to like 'The Office' the first time they see it because they're not going to know what they're watching exactly.

"But if you stick to your vision and auteur it the way you think it should be done, there are enough people in the world that are like-minded and they're going to find it and it's going to be their favorite show," he said.
