

Pooches show off their stuff at show

Lugged out already? Can't tell a triple axel from Jeanne Tripplehorn? Overwhelmed by medals and moguls?

Does the sight of a cross-country ski race make you feel guilty about that Nordic Track machine that's been sitting in your laundry room since 1998?

Perhaps you need a break from the Winter Olympics. Trade in some alpine skiing for strutting Affenpinschers, frisky corgis, Siberian huskies and standard schnauzers.

Yes, we're talking about the 130th "Westminster Kennel Club Dog Show" (8 p.m., USA, concludes Tuesday). This is the 23rd consecutive year that USA has carried Westminster, the second oldest still-running sporting event in the United States.

Only the Kentucky Derby is more venerable. To put it in perspective, Rutherford B. Hayes was president when Westminster began in 1877.

The electric light bulb had not yet been invented. When the first World Series game was played in 1903, Westminster had already been running for 26 years. And Joe Garagiola had nothing to do with either of them.

Canine expert David Frei will help cover this year's Westminster, his 17th show. He'll be joined by veterinarian Debbye Turner ("The Early Show") and entertainment reporter Jill Rappaport ("The Today Show").

But tonight goes to the dogs. More than 2,600 four-legged entrants, representing 165 breeds, will compete within their categories and then vie for the ultimate title: best in show.

And speaking of a breed apart, I can't get enough of the dog handlers, the folks in the oversized outfits and sensible shoes who run after their little Pomeranians and Papillons with a detached-yet-deliberate air that always makes for funny television.

• What is this thing called love? Poets from Catullus to Cole Porter have been trying to define, describe and celebrate it.

But that was so pre-21st century. To some, l'amour boils down to a formula, an Erlenmeyer flask full of pheromones or the spark resulting from a crossed connection in a jangled ganglion.

In this spirit, the series "Naked Science" (9 p.m., National Geographic) reduces the pursuit of love to a show called "What's Sexy?"

"Sexy" talks to neurologists and researchers who think they're pretty close to figuring out the physical and chemical reactions that we call love.

Says one: "The part of the brain that becomes active when you look at a photograph of your lover, it's exactly the same region

of the brain that becomes active when you feel the rush of cocaine."

Perhaps the poets and the scientists aren't that far apart. Bryan Ferry sang "Love is the Drug," way back in the late 1970s. It looks like Roxy Music was on to something.

TV host wants cushy job as Finnish sauna inspector

Conan O'Brien, who endorsed the re-election of Finnish President Tarja Halonen with mock ad campaigns because they both have red hair and fair skin, said he expects to be rewarded with a Cabinet position.

Hundreds of fans welcomed O'Brien on Saturday to a freezing Helsinki, only two weeks after Halonen, 62, secured a second six-year term as Finland's first female president.

After arriving at the airport, the quirky, self-deprecating NBC network host said he will ask Halonen for a Cabinet position when he meets her Tuesday.

"In my country, when someone is instrumental in helping someone get elected it's customary for the president to give that person a Cabinet or ministerial position," O'Brien told reporters in the airport's VIP lounge.

"I'd like to be the inspector of saunas, mostly women's saunas," he said.

O'Brien has joked that his show is highly popular in Finland because

of his resemblance to the fair-skinned, red-haired Halonen. Last year, he caused a political stir by endorsing her during her campaign, broadcasting mock ads promoting her and attacking her opponents.

After his Tuesday meeting at the presidential palace with Halonen, O'Brien is to receive a TV award for being the most surprising and entertaining TV personality in Finland.

Bling vs. art: Car fanatic creates heirlooms

Jay Leno says it's easy to spot the difference between the Chip Foose "Overhaulin'" dream-machine transformations and those from other car rehab shows.

"It's bling versus art. Simple as that," the "Tonight Show" host says.

"He's a real artist. When people see a statue they think of an artist, but when they see metal with wheels it doesn't register. But it's true art. When you're doing something of an automotive nature it has to perform and still retain the beauty of it. That's why Chip is really good."

The car bling-thing — 24-inch chrome wheels, wild paint schemes and outrageous audio and video enhancements — are common on cable television these days, with MTV's "Pimp My Ride" leading the pack.

Those shows transform just about anything that rolls, including neglected vehicles that should be dismissed as junkyard crushers. Automotive designer Foose's "Overhaulin'" (The Learning Channel, 9 p.m. Tuesdays) operates on a higher plane. Make that car.

Hosts Adrienne Janic and Chris Jacobs concoct an elaborate ruse, with the help of a car-buff's family and friends, to smooth the way for "Overhaulin'"

crew members to swoop in and "steal" a vintage automobile that has long been on the restoration back-burner.

At his Huntington Beach shop, the Foose team tears cars apart and puts them back together with a new motor, transmission, suspension, interior, Foose-brand wheels and custom paint.

It's an act of love, the 41-year-old Foose says.

"There's not a better natural high in all the world than to see what everybody's created and do an unveil," Foose said. "We cre-

ate a relationship. I want to build cars people can have for the rest of their lives. I want them to have a family heirloom."

Now in its fourth season on The Learning Channel, "Overhaulin'" has restored 47 vehicles, usually 1950s, 1960s and 1970s muscle cars.

Show producers cull through 15,000 submissions a week to pick a car for the Foose touch.
