Sealed Bids for the Elevated Water Storage Tanks Project for the Town Council, Town of Edinburgh, Indiana (herein called the "Owner") will be received by the Owner at the Town Hall, 107 South Holland Street, Edinburgh, IN 46124 until February 13, 2007 at 11:00 a.m. (local time). Any Bids received later than the above time will be returned unopened.

The work shall include: The construction of two (2) 750,000 - gallon Elevated Steel Pedestal Water Storage Tanks and appurtenances including excavation, foundation, erection, panning, piping, drainage structures, fencing, site restoration, and other related work. The work shall also include the installation of 50 (+/-) and 370 (+/-) linear feet of 12 D.I. and C-900 PVC pipe respectively with related valves, fittings, hydrants, and appurtenances including all necessary excavation, grading, erosion control, seeding, and site restoration. The work also includes the demolition and removal on one (1) 300,000 gallon and one (1) 500,000-gallon Elevated Steel Legged Water Storage Tank.

Work shall be constructed under a Lump Sum Contract.

Bids shall be properly and completely executed on a State Board of Contractors Form 96 (Revised 2005). Wage rates on the project shall not be less than the prescribed scale of wages as determined in accordance with Indiana Code 36-31-2-1, commonly referred to as the Prevailing Wage Law.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or minor defects in bids or bidding procedure, or reject any and all bids, or to accept any bid as may be lowest or most responsible as exclusively determined by the Owner. Any bid may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time for the opening of bids or authorized postponement thereof.
