NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Town of Bargersville, Indiana, by and through its Town Council, hereinafter referred to as the OWNER, will receive sealed proposals for the construction of the Stones Crossing and Morgantown Roads Water Main Replacement Project in the Town of Bargersville, Johnson County, Indiana.

Sealed proposals are invited and may be delivered or forwarded by registered mail, addressed to the Town Council in care of the Clerk-Treasurer until 4:30 P.M. (local time) on Tuesday, March 13, 2007, at the Town Hall, 24 North Main, Bargersville, Indiana, 46106. Proposals received after this hour will be returned unopened. Bids received prior to this time shall be opened and publicly read.

The Project, which is funded by local funds, will be constructed in one (1) contract division and is defined and outlined as follows:

The project includes, but is not limited to, the furnishing and installation of approximately 5,000 lineal feet of 12" PVC water main and appurtenances. The work includes the following items: water main, gate valves, hydrants, connections to existing water mains, granular backfill, temporary pavement restoration, seeding and mulching, service reconnections and meter pit relocations.

Approved performance and payment bonds guaranteeing faithful and proper performance of the work and materials, to be executed by an acceptable surety company, will be required of the Contractor at the time he executes his contract. The bonds will be in the amount of 100% of the Contract Price and must be in full force and effect for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of acceptance and of final payment for the work.
