Despite a slow start Saturday, the Center Grove girls basketball team picked up a 55-42 victory against Rushville.

The host Lions jumped to a 19-13 first quarter lead and went into the break with a 26-20 advantage.

Center Grove (10-3, 1-1) forced the Lions into 24 turnovers.

Senior forward Hillary Bowling led all scorers with 17 points. Center Grove senior Alex Dewitz added 12.

The Trojans will be at home Thursday against Metropolitan Interscholastic Conference foe North Central.

The Grizzly Cubs held an 18-17 edge at halftime and gradually stretched their lead as Franklin put three players in double figures.

Freshman forward Carley Buchanan led all scorers with 15 points while senior guard Lindsey Vandivier and senior Kristin Chaney each scored 13. Each also had six rebounds. Senior Nancy Miller had eight boards.

Franklin next test comes Wednesday at Perry Meridian.
