



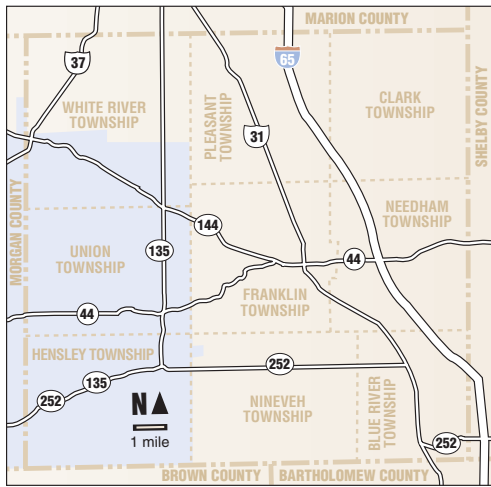
INDIANA GENERAL ASSEMBLY: MEET YOUR LEGISLATORS

Senate District 37, Republican



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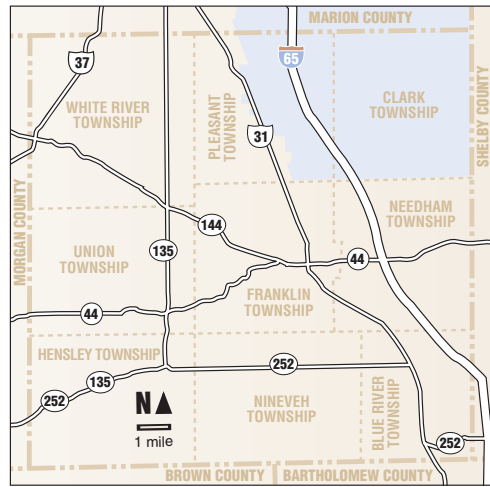
District 37 includes Hensley and Union Townships and portions of White River Township. The district extends into Clay, Monroe, Morgan, Owen and Putnam counties.

Senate District 32, Republican



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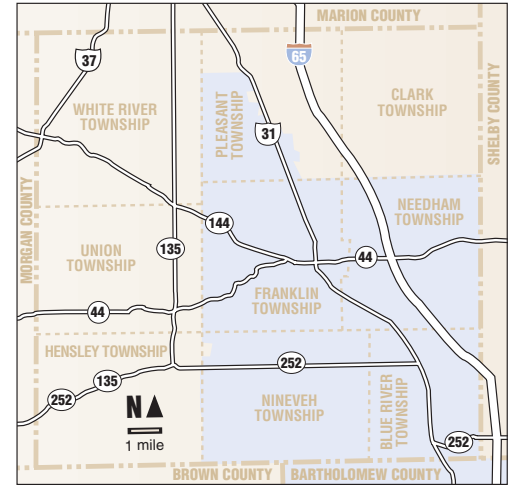
District 32 includes parts of the city of Greenwood and Pleasant Township and all of Clark Township. The district also includes portions of Marion County.

Senate District 41, Republican



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District 41 includes all of Blue River, Needham and Franklin townships, most of Nineveh Township and portions of Pleasant Township. The district extends into Bartholomew County.

BILLS

Require specific training for law enforcement workers who interview children on how to handle them best.
 Status: Not yet filed

Require people who process adoptions to be licensed. Make the offense a Class A misdemeanor if the person processing the application is not licensed.
 Status: Not yet filed

Require training for coroners on how to identify bodies and determine cause of death. If the person does not receive training, they are not paid.
 Status: Proposed

Re-establish on a temporary

basis the state commission on forensic sciences to study the creation of a medical examiner system to assist coroners.
 Status: Proposed

Make a constitutional amendment to change the requirements for someone to become coroner to include certain training and experience.
 Status: Not yet filed

Allow the adoption of stored embryos after five years if the doctor has made efforts to contact the donors.
 Status: Not yet filed

BILLS

Increase mandatory sentences for adults convicted of battering a child.
 Status: Not yet filed

Allow judges and juries to consider an offender's entire criminal history, not just felonies, in cases where

the person is charged as a habitual offender.
 Status: Not yet filed

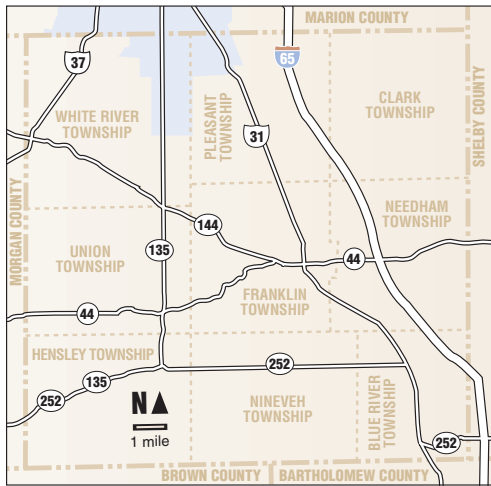
Restrict the access of sexually explicit materials for sex offenders on home detention or parole.

Senate District 36, Republican



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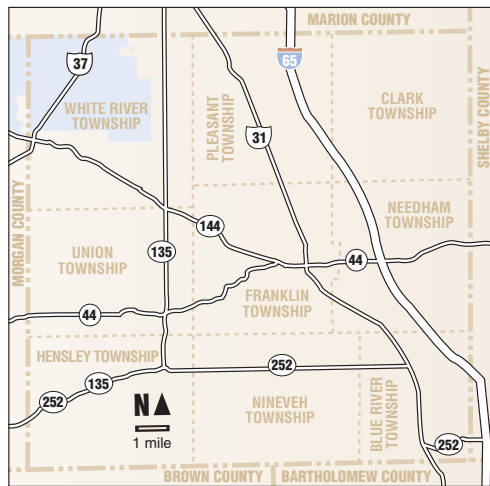
District 36 includes portions of the city of Greenwood and portions of White River Township. Most of the district is in Marion County.

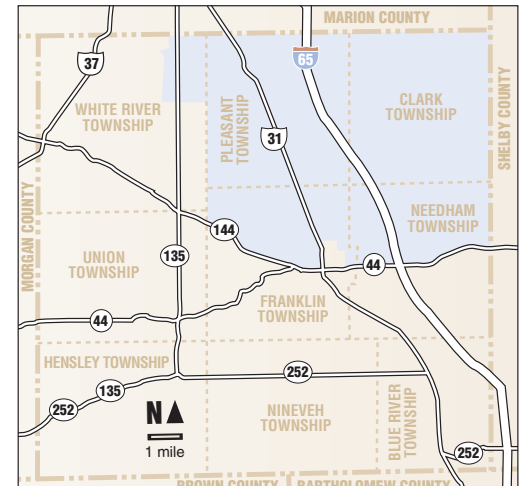
District 35 includes portions of White River Township. The district extends into Marion and Morgan counties.

House District 58, Republican



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District 58 includes Greenwood, New Whiteland, Whiteland, Clark Township and portions of the city of Franklin and Needham and Franklin townships.

BILLS

A constitutional amendment freezing property taxes at current levels. Increased funds that would be needed for government expenses would come from state or income taxes, which would be decided by local officials.
 Status: Not yet filed

Prohibits the installation of an automated teller machine on a riverboat. Requires certain riverboat patrons who wish to obtain or access a line of credit to submit to a breath test and have a blood-alcohol level less than .08 percent.
 Status: Proposed

Judges can decide to make defen-

dants in criminal trials pay fees to cover the cost to prosecute the case. The judge would decide if the person was able to pay the money and how much. Prosecutors would write invoices of the cost to prosecute the case by the hour. The money would go into the county general fund.
 Status: Proposed

Allow school boards to put \$25,000 per year into schools' education foundation programs and activities that enhance the quality of education or extend learning opportunities for students of the school corporation.
 Status: Proposed

BILLS

Local governments can't increase taxes to fund mistakes made when granting tax abatements to a company.
 Status: Not yet filed

Homeowners associations must inform interested homebuyers if the previous owner has outstanding bills to the association.
 Status: Not yet filed

Homesellers must inform potential buyers if a methamphetamine lab

was found inside the home within the past two years. The state also must keep a registry of the homes where methamphetamine labs were found.
 Status: Not yet filed

Property taxes would be frozen at the current level. Increases in costs for services would be funded through increases in sales and income taxes dictated at the local level.
 Status: Not yet filed

BILLS

Establish a phone number people can call to get help with affording housing. People can call to get help instead of being foreclosed on. Funding would go through the Indiana Housing Authority and would cost about \$5 million.
 Status: Not yet filed

Those who hire or house illegal immigrants would face stiffer penalties.
 Status: Not yet filed

Repeal property taxes within the next four years. Start planning how

expenses would be paid for without property taxes.
 Status: Not yet filed

Stop large retail and grocery stores from selling alcohol or requires them to put the alcohol behind the counter to stop underage drinkers from stealing it.
 Status: Not yet filed

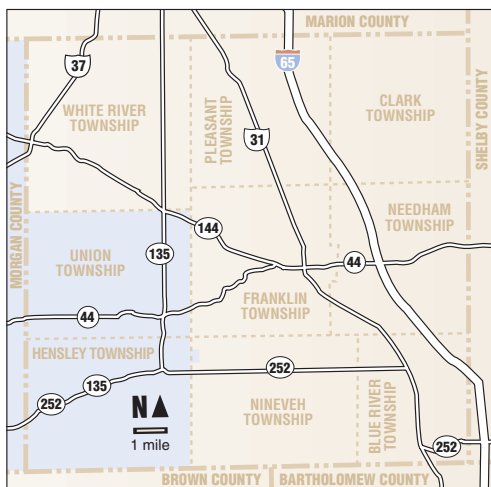
Repeal legislation that requires churches to get a food handlers permit for pitch-ins.

House District 47, Republican



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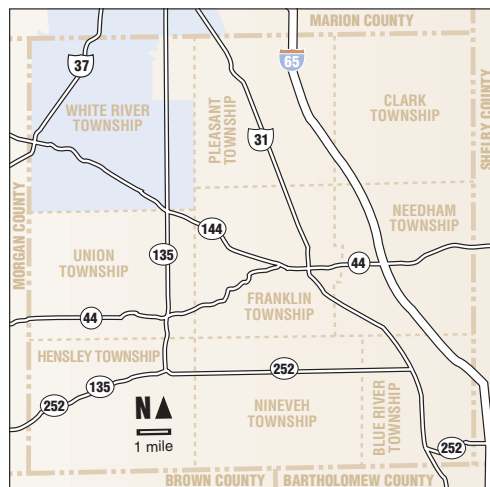
District 47 includes Union and Hensley townships. The district covers most of Morgan County and portions of Hendricks and Owen counties.

House District 93, Republican



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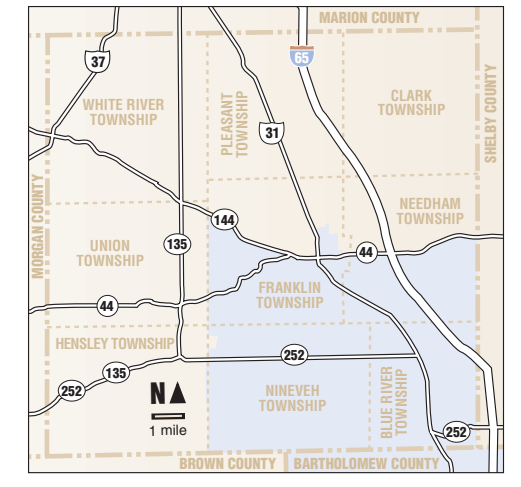
District 93 includes most of White River Township. It also extends to Perry Township in Marion County.

BILLS

Allow local governments to decide what hours residents can set off fireworks.
 Status: Not yet filed

Require that all school board elections in Indiana be conducted during the general election.

Status: Not yet filed

Offer hospitals and health-care providers areas and ways to recycle unused prescription drugs that can be given to the poor.
 Status: Not yet filed

BILLS

New assessments based on market value are not valid unless they include assessments previous to 2007.
 Status: Not yet filed

Require that all residential properties are assessed the same. Some rental properties that include multiple units currently are assessed as commercial properties and should not be.
 Status: Not yet filed

Postpone for one year a reassessment of property values based on market value.
 Status: Not yet filed

Propose the state pick up the 10

percent cost of a land use study at Camp Atterbury, a military base near Edinburgh, that a federal grant doesn't cover.
 Status: Not yet filed

Propose a 10-cent deposit on plastic bottles and aluminum cans that would be repaid when the items are returned to the store where they were purchased to promote recycling.

Require every law that passes to have a clause defining the intent of the bill.
