The wedding is set for June 2 at Mount Pleasant Christian Church in Greenwood.



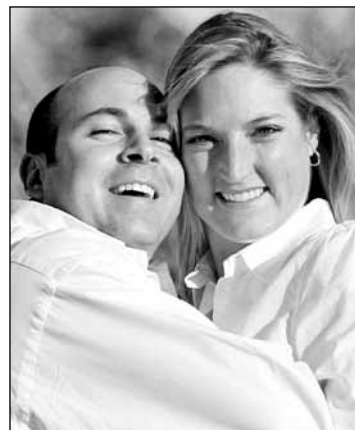
Megan Engle Nick Ciaccio

They have three children, Ben Bryant of Mooresville, Emma Ray of Greenwood and Taylor Bryant of Franklin; and two grandchildren.



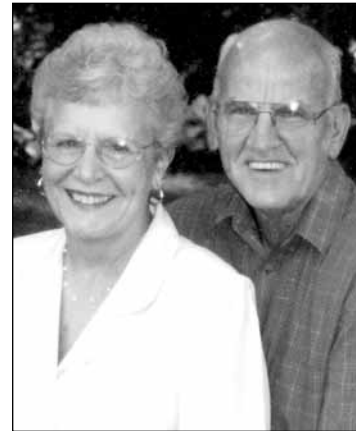
Jenkins
